



WEST REGION CUP EVENTS CODE OF CONDUCT December 2017



Teams competing in the West Region Presidents Cup or Far West Regional Championships (NCS) series are representatives of their State Associations. Players, Coaches, teams and spectators are expected to conduct themselves in an appropriate manner during the event, both on and away from the playing venue. Violation of one or more criteria set within this Code of Conduct can jeopardize the player's, coach, team, spectator, referee or event official participation for the duration of the event. In addition, the appropriate local authorities and the person's State Association will be notified for their review.

1. A player, coach, spectator, referee or event official found using or in the possession of illegal drugs, alcohol or in violation of any US Youth Soccer Association Rule, at the venue may be denied participation for the duration of the event.
2. A player, coach, spectator, referee or event official found furnishing illegal drugs or alcohol to players or youth referees or in violation of any US Youth Soccer Association Rule, may be denied participation for the duration of the event.
3. A player, coach, spectator or referee who has displayed violations of local ordinances (including, but not limited to, theft or willful destruction of property) can be subject to denial from participation at each level of the competition by the appropriate Cup Committee.
4. A player, coach, spectator or referee who physically or verbally attacks another player, coach, spectator, or event official can be subject to denial from participation for the duration of the event.

Violations of this Code will be reviewed by the appropriate Cup Committee at the event. Actions of the Cup Committee can be appealed through established protocol.
