- Membership Development & Support: Collaborate with member clubs and leagues and maintain positive and service-oriented relationships. Drive the development of new clubs or leagues, contributing to the expansion of Georgia Soccer.
- **Sponsorship and PR:** Lead marketing and Public Relations efforts. Maintain a positive relationship with sponsors and partners to fulfill commitments and explore new opportunities. Identify and apply for grant programs and oversee existing Innovate to Grow Coaching, Referee and Community grants.
