Opening Ceremony/Player Event

- Date: Thursday July 10th
- Time: Doors open at 4:00PM; Parents/spectators are welcome
- Eccation: <u>Yuengling Center</u>, 12499 USF Bull Run Drive, Tampa, Florida 33620
- Goody Bag Distribution: As they enter, *Team Manager or Coach* should pick up their team goody bag at their regional table located nearest the assigned seats
- Water available for Players/Coaches on the Arena Floor; Beverages for sale for all others.
- Begins at 5:30PM; Teams should be in their seats NO LATER than 5:15PM

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Player Event

Players will have access to the arena floor where they can take pictures with the championship trophies and trade items with their fellow competitors

Team Seating Assignments:

- East sections 120, 121, 122, 220, 221 and 222
- Midwest sections 102, 103, 202 and 203
- South sections 112, 113, 114, 115, 213 and 214
- Far West sections 116, 117, 118, 216, 217, 218
- Spectators may sit in seats not occupied by players or coaches; please let teams utilize the sections closest the arena floor.





- For those that are having to miss the Player Event due to flight schedules, etc.
- You need to coordinate with your Regional Program Manager to get your goody bag BEFORE YOUR FIRST MATCH!!
- Your goody bag will contain your Best 11 Voting forms as well as your Bench
 Passes, so please make sure you know how to contact your Program Manager!

Trading at Player Event

- Once the formalities are over, players are released to the arena floor. They can meet and interact with their fellow competitors from all over the country.
- Suggest each player have 10-15 (more? / less?.. Up to you!) items to start trading.
- Trade ideas include pins, memorabilia, hats, t-shirts, and other items that help define your state and culture. The sky is the limit!
- The only rule is that both parties have to agree on the trade.
- Perpetual trophies will be on display to take photos with, both before the Player Event starts and during the trading.

Bench Credentials & Member Passes

- Team Officials must wear the National Presidents Cup Bench Pass (issued with team Goody Bags) around their neck; Please don't create an issue with this!
- Maximum of 4 team officials in the technical area
- Players, coaches, managers, and/or team trainers must:
 - Be listed on the event roster,
 - Have a current USYS/State Association member pass with a recent photo
- All team member passes must be presented to the referee at the field prior to each match
- No rosters are required, team rosters are printed on the match card
- Missing member passes? Contact your State Rep immediately!



Reminders

- The Code of Conduct teams agreed to for the Regional events are still in full force and effect

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Uniforms

- Each team must have two (2) uniform sets, including socks (one light color & one dark color) at each match during the competition
- Bring both uniform sets to each match (Home team wears light colored jersey & socks; Away team wears dark colored jersey & socks)
- If there is a jersey or sock color conflict, the team causing the conflict must change. The referee's decision is final.
- Permanent numbers; NO tape permitted
- Competing organization/league logos permanently covered; USYS has semi-permanent patches available (\$3 each or \$75 for 44 patches, cash only, no checks or credit cards). Available at Event Headquarters. NO tape permitted!
- Violations can result in loss of team subsidy...
- See Rule 210 for all uniform requirements

Patches

- (Insert Heavy Sigh...)
- I am SO sorry! The manufacturer shorted us on the shipment and with Tariffs and other shipping issues we just don't have enough to go around.
- The requirement outlined has been relaxed. There will be no sanctions or penalty if teams do not have them on OR if some players do and other don't.
- We have ordered more. If you are short and want them for players as a souvenir/remembrance, etc., please send a shipping contact and address to your Regional Program Manager.
- Once they arrive we will ship them out to you.

Match Procedures

- Referee crew will have the match card
- Any Medical or Disciplinary suspensions will already be crossed off the match card
- Recommend a Team Official confirm Goal Scorers and all Yellow/Red Cards with 4th Official to ensure accuracy
- A credentialed Team Official from *each team* signs the match card; PLEASE DO NOT COMPLAIN ABOUT THE MATCH TO THE REFEREES WHILE SIGNING!
- Once signed, NO changes will be entertained unless there is a data entry error.
- If there is a score or goal scorer discrepancy, it must be communicated by a
 Credentialed Team Official at HQ

Match Procedures (continued)

- International Walk Out for each match, 3 minutes before kickoff; All rostered players should walk out, including subs and players not participating in the match
- If necessary, water breaks will be implemented by the Event Management Group;
 3-minutes max and referees will add time at the end of the half to compensate
- Unlimited substitutions at the half line are allowed during any stoppage of play with the approval of the referee
- Inactive players should be in street clothes; Subs must wear a different color vest on the bench at all times
- Remember to fill out and RETURN your Best 11 Form; you are ranking your OWN PLAYERS!
- After the match, please ensure that the bench area is clean, and your team leaves ASAP so the next team can get settled

Individual Awards to Players

- Individual awards are based on voting during all matches teams play, and players from any team are eligible to win an individual award
- The Best 11 award will be presented to the top ranked players in the competition in each age/gender
- Best 11 is based on coaches ranking players on *their own team;* Teams failing to submit a voting form for all matches severely impacts players chances of selection
- Golden Boot and Golden Glove honors will be presented to the top scorer and the outstanding goalkeeper in each age group/gender
- Most Valuable Player award will be presented to the highest rated player in the Best 11
- A player ejected from a match is not eligible for any individual award!
- Best 11 forms will be distributed in team goody bags picked up by the team manager or coach before the start of the Player Event
- All individual awards will be publicly announced and sent to winners as soon as possible after the conclusion of the competition; however, the process may take up to 6-8 weeks

Discriminatory Language/Actions

- US Youth Soccer rejects any form of discrimination, harassment or epithets directed towards an individual based on race, color, gender, sexual orientation, religion, national origin, age or physical/mental disability.
- If a Referee *hears* an epithet by a Player or Team Official:
 - an Ejection (Red Card) will result.
- If an epithet is *reported* to a Referee by a Player or Team Official:
 - A meeting on the Player's side of the field will take place.
 - Coaches will be permitted to inform their team that any further incidents may result in an immediate ejection, a temporary suspension of the match, the match being abandoned and/or teams being removed from the competition. For a match that is not resumed, the score when the match was stopped will stand.

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Discriminatory Language/Actions by Spectators

If an epithet by a Spectator is *heard by* or *reported to* a Referee:

- The match will be stopped, and players directed to their benches.
- Both Head Coaches will be advised of what was heard/reported.
- Coaches will be requested to inform their spectators that any further incidents could result in a temporary suspension of the match, removal of all spectators from the match, the match being abandoned and/or teams being removed from the competition. For a match that is not resumed, the score when the match was stopped will stand.
- The Head Coach may ask their spectators to help identify any offending spectator(s).
- If the spectator is identified, they will be asked to leave. If they do not comply, Security will intervene.
- Additionally, all spectators from the offending team may be removed for the balance of the match *and/or future matches*.

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Cautions & Ejections

- No accumulation of cautions (Yellow Cards) from match to match during the competition.
- Ejected players may continue to sit on the team bench if they do not create any further disturbance.
- Ejected Team Officials must immediately remove themselves from sight and sound of the match before it will be restarted. This is a NATIONAL event; we expect exemplary behavior from Team Officials! Ejected Team Officials should expect a heavy sanction; most likely they will not be on the sideline for the remainder of the event...or even into next season.
- Any ejection (Red Card) will result in a minimum of a one match suspension; all ejections will be reviewed, and additional penalties, suspensions, or other disciplinary actions may be imposed depending on the circumstances and severity of the infraction.
- Ejections for Violent Conduct or Serious Foul Play may result in multiple match suspensions
- Players or Team Officials sent off for Discriminatory Language/Actions and/or Referee Abuse/Assault should expect MULTIPLE MATCH suspensions which could carry over to the next seasonal year, and/or possible removal from the National Presidents Cup competition (see above!).
- Additionally, any Regional and/or National team subsidy could be forfeited.

Referees

- Referees have earned their place based on their performance at the Regional Presidents Cup events
- Identical to the Regional competitions, referees are supported by mentors who contribute to their development by guiding them in post-match reflections
- If a Team Official is sent off for referee abuse, there is a good chance that they won't coach again during the week
- Presidents Cup and USYS WILL NOT tolerate ANY referee abuse and WILL NOT hesitate to clear the sidelines
- Please familiarize your team with the recently enacted USSF Referee Abuse Policy!



Athletic Trainers

- Trainers will be available for preventative taping services
- All medical injuries have priority
- The event Trainers are primary; Team or club trainers are secondary
- See Team Information Guide for hospital and urgent care facility listings



USYS Concussion Protocol

- If a player receives a completed USYS Concussion Form due to displaying signs and symptoms of a concussion, that player may not return to play until a signed clearance form from a medical doctor or doctor of osteopath who specializes in concussion treatment and management has been received
 - For clarification, whether an M.D. or D.O., the physician must specialize in concussion treatment and management
 - Clearances signed by a PA are not acceptable

Championship Matches

- Immediately following your championship match, BOTH teams MUST make their way to the awards area
- Finalist medals and plaque will be presented first, followed by the Champion medals, cup and perpetual trophy

Team Video Information

- Teams and spectators may use their own recording devices within their spectator area, which is directly across from their team bench
- Tripods and other supporting equipment MUST be securely staked down behind their own spectators
- VEO or similar cameras must be placed a minimum of 3 yards into the spectator area from the half line and behind their own spectators

Spectators

- Spectators who may be reasonably construed as being associated with a team are the responsibility of the credentialed team officials appearing on the roster.
- Regional Competitions had issues with some spectators using Discriminatory Language/Actions towards players; Offenders will be ejected if identified and/or sidelines will be cleared.
- Whistles, air horns, megaphones, artificial noisemakers and/or ANY similar devices are prohibited.
- See Rule 215 for further details

Final Reminders

- Carefully REVIEW your final event roster
 Final Roster Freeze is 11:59PM CDT Thursday July 3!
- ✓ Online Check-In: Upload member passes by July 6, 11:59PM CDT
- ✓ Team Official bench passes
- Member passes
- ✓ Uniform requirements
- National Patches are not required due to limited availability. This is a change from previously published information.
- Hydration stations at each First Aid tent;
 Players must bring their own container
- ✓ USYS provides shade tents over team benches
- Spectators should use umbrellas for shade;
 Sportsplex does not have room for spectator tents
- ✓ Know who your State Rep is AND how to contact them!
